# LORD OF LIFE BOOK CLUB

The Lord of Life Book Club will meet on Wednesday, December 6<sup>th</sup> at 4:45 pm. This will be a planning session for choosing books for discussion throughout 2024. Join us January 3<sup>rd</sup> at 4:45 pm as we discuss the book "The Black Echo" by Michael Connelly. The Black Echo is the first book in the Harry Bosch detective series. It follows Harry as he gets demoted to the Hollywood homicide desk after killing the main suspect in a serial killer investigation. In the Black Echo, one of Bosch's old war buddies, Billy Meadows is killed. Bosch connects the death to a bank robbery and works with the FBI to solve the case. The entire plot of The Black Echo is driven by Bosch's investigation of the murder of his friend, and this introductory novel also uses the story to explain Bosch's origins, his Vietnam story as a "tunnel rat".
